

**SIX-POINTED STAR:** The six-pointed star provides the formula for the return of Shekhina. It contains the message of quantum mechanics, the inter-related universe. The star illustrates the concept of "as above, so below" and visa versa. Rabbi Berg (Pg. 193) points out that it is not a part of Judaism that the Divine rewards obedience and punishes the disobedient. "It is rather the thought and actions...which result in the...consequences which we think of as rewards and punishments." As stated in the L'CHAH DODI by

Rabbi Alqabetz (16th century) by the phrase "Sof Ma-a-sei B'machshavah T'chilah:" "All manifestations and actions are merely the results of a *priori* thought." (See Berg, Pg. 85.) The star also represents sexual union. The act of sacred love-making on the evening of the Sabbath creates a divine union on Earth which aids the divine union in Heaven. As below, so above. The Sabbath "celebration" facilitates the Return of Shekhina and the reunification of the Divinity. We bring about the Messianic era.
